You may bring witnesses and other evidence.

When filing your Appearance and Response, you must include a Proof of Service that certifies that you served the Petitioner(s) or Petitioner(s) attorney/advocate(s), whose name(s) and address(es) appear below.

You may file the APPEARANCE, RESPONSE, and PROOF OF SERVICE by mailing it or delivering it to the Court Clerk at the court address at the top of this form within 20 days of the date on which this Summons was served on you.

WARNING: If you fail to serve an Appearance or Answer in the time stated above, or if, after you answer, you fail to appear on the day and time the Court notifies you to do so, a judgment by default may be entered against you for the relief demanded in the Petition. A default judgment may include sanctions authorized by sections 8.6.1 - 8.6.3 of the San Manuel Disorderly Conduct Ordinance, such as a fine, restitution, exclusion from Tribal events, facilities or lands for up to 20 years, or require you to participate in other activities or programs designed to address the activity underlying the disorderly conduct (e.g. community service, substance abuse treatment, counseling, etc.).
